Cedar LNG Advances Construction

On June 25, 2024, Haisla members of the community gathered in the Village as Cedar LNG declared a positive Final Investment Decision (FID) for the world's first Indigenous majority-owned LNG facility. Construction is underway with operations anticipated by the end of 2028.

We are grateful to all those who attended the FID event and shared their support. Community dinners will be held in Kitimaat Village and Vancouver in early 2025 to celebrate Cedar LNG's positive FID.



Construction Progress

Construction commenced shortly after FID in early July 2024, with a focus on the marine terminal area and the pipeline right of way, to prepare for a full construction season in 2025.

The innovative floating LNG unit is also under development overseas for delivery to Kitimat in 2028.



Jobs & Opportunities

Cedar LNG is anticipated to create up to 500 jobs during peak construction and approximately 100 full-time jobs during operations. Preference in hiring will be given to Haisla members, Indigenous and local workers, and companies that meet our qualifications.

During construction, our contractors will be responsible for direct hiring to meet their labour needs, however, Cedar LNG is committed to working with our contractors to ensure they understand our commitments.

While hiring for operations will commence in 2027, Cedar LNG is currently focused on sharing information about training and skills needed to receive employment during operations.

Proposed Design Refinements

Cedar LNG is also pursuing refinements to its approved design based on additional detailed engineering and construction planning.
